- How can we better care for one another today?
- What is difficult about being in a community?

RESPONSE

- In what ways is your relationship with Jesus personal? In what ways is your relationship with Jesus corporate?
- Do you have a time in life when you felt like you were all on your own with only the Lord to stand with you? How have you experienced the Lord's faithfulness in your life?
- Remember the assignments: (1) Read the book of 2 Timothy once a week. (2) Connect with one person from Baseline each week just to check in. (3) Take time each day to listen for the Holy Spirit asking you: "Who are you? And, what are you doing here?"
